## 2019-2020 SUPPLY LIST FOR STUDENTS ENTERING MIDDLE SCHOOL

(All required supplies must be replaced as needed throughout the year.)

Backpack (no rolling) must fit in cubby  
Drawstring bag (for PE clothes and sneakers)  
Three 1" binders with clear front sleeve, write on tab dividers, and reinforcements for looseleaf, and interior pockets (Lit, Math and SS)  
(Religion) 1 large spiral notebook (9x11) and one journal (may be a composition book)  
3 composition books (2 for Science, 1 for Language Arts )  
2 two-pocket folders (Science and SS)  
6 packages of looseleaf (then buy as needed) (reinforced is best for binders)  
4 packages of 4" x 6" index cards (then buy as needed)  
1 box or package of blue or black pens (must have at least 2 per day)  
Sharpened pencils (for home and school, mandatory for Math and Science)  
3 hole punch to fit in binder  
earbuds

Class Art Supplies (in a pencil pouch to carry to classes)

Coloring supplies (crayons, markers, colored pencils or twistables)

Highlighters

3 rolls of scotch tape (needed daily for Science)

4 glue sticks

1 hand held covered pencil sharpener

2 packages dry erase whiteboard markers (Math)
