

IXL Summer Requirements

Students in grades K-2 will have required IXL Skills to complete over the summer. **Each child will be required to complete the Summer Adventure Skill Plan, and spend 10-15 minutes per week in the Diagnostic Arena.** This needs to be completed by August 8, 2022, however please note that this is designed as a weekly plan for students to stay on target with skills. Follow the steps below to complete both of these requirements.

Summer Adventures: To view the required skills please login to IXL.com and complete the following steps.

1. Login to IXL.com (use the website rather than the app)
2. Click skill plans
3. You will see "Pinned Skill Plans"- Summer Adventures (combines math and reading)

These skills are broken down into 20 days of summer practice, and **all are required to be completed.** Please have students work throughout the summer on these skills.

All skills in this plan must be completed.

Weekly Diagnostic Arena: Students are also **required** to spend 10-15 minutes per week in the Diagnostic Arena. Follow these steps to enter the arena.

1. Login to IXL.com
2. Click Diagnostic
3. Click step into arena to begin assessments.

Upon completion of the weekly arena time there will be a list of practice skills generated by your child's results in the arena. This is a great way to keep your child on target for the next school year. To view these skills click on practice. Your child has been using this in class all year, and should be very familiar with the process. The practice skills are not part of the requirement, however it is highly recommended to give your child extra practice. Your child may complete any additional skills, or games over the summer for additional practice.
