- Capital Campaign news
 - Girls' bathrooms finished. Next project is renovating boys bathrooms, including making space for an adult bathroom (per code). Estimate is \$500,000 and we are starting from scratch for that money (girls' bathrooms cost was \$450,000).
 - Windows installed along north side of building (\$150,000)
