All required supplies must be replaced as needed throughout the year.

ELA

One, 1 inch binder with clear front sleeve, write on tab dividers, reinforcements for loose-leaf and interior pockets.

Science

1 roll of paper towels (for use during labs)

Social Studies

One, 1 ½ inch binder with clear front sleeve, write on tab dividers, reinforcements for loose-leaf and interior pockets

2 packages of 4" x 6" index cards (1 stay at home and 1 for school)

3 highlighters – **one yellow, one pink, and one orange**

Religion

1 large spiral notebook (9 by 11)

1 journal (may be a composition book)

Math

1 box of sharpened pencils (for school and home). No erasable pens!

1 package of BLACK expo markers – these will be collected

One, 1 ½ inch binder with clear front sleeve, tab dividers, reinforcements for loose-leaf, interior pockets or folder with three holes and a pencil pouch that will remain stocked and in binder for Mrs. Huseinovic's math classes

3-hole punch to fit into the binder

OR

Two, 5 subject notebooks with pockets for other math classes

Middle School supplies, continued

Band Students

1" white binder

Sheet protectors (at least 10)

Pencils

Woodwinds: at least 3 working reeds at all times (strength 2.5 or 3, Rico or Vandoren)

Brass: Slide oil or grease

Cleaning swab/supplies specific to instrument

ALL

6 packages of loose-leaf paper (reinforced is best for binder. (then buy as needed)

1 pair of earbuds (for the iPad) Label with your name.

4 packages of blue or black pens (must have 2 pens per day)

1 package of black sharpies

1 box of latex free bandaids

Water bottle brought daily **Not to exceed 32 oz.

Regular stapler for at home.

10, ½ size poster boards – to be kept at home until needed.

Pencil case for supplies

Class Art Supplies

Coloring Supplies (colored pencils, Twistables, markers, or crayons)

1 pack of highlighters (containing 5 or more - with a variety of colors)

6 packages of Scotch tape

4 glue sticks

1 hand held **covered** pencil sharpener. Label with your name.

1 pair of scissors

You must always have a physical book for Silent Reading Time in all classes. (This book must be other than iPad, Kindle, etc.)

In addition:

Each student entering grades 6, 7, and 8 must bring in 2 boxes of tissues

Each student entering Grade 6 brings 400 3x5" lined index cards

Each student entering Grade 7 brings 1 bottle (12oz) of hand sanitizer and 1 container of Clorox Wipes

Each student entering Grade 8 brings 2 rolls of paper towels

White-Out is not allowed!
